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# APPENDIX 1

## Appendix 1- Site Assessments

A site assessment was undertaken for each open space identified. This considered eight categories when analysing the quality of each open space. Sub-categories were used where there were a number of associated features, the average score of the sub-categories made up the total category score. Each category could score a maximum of 5; a score of 5 indicated excellent quality. If all categories were considered, an open space could score a maximum of 40 points, this was converted into a percentage and rated as 'low', 'medium' or 'high' quality when compared to open spaces across Exmoor (see chapter 2.0 for further description).

For some open spaces it was not appropriate to consider all eight categories. In these instances the category regarded as unsuitable to the type of open space was removed from the total score so that the percentage reflected the open space fairly. For example, a small allotment would not be expected to provide public facilities such as toilets or play areas, therefore the category 'facilities' was removed from the analysis of this open space and the percentage was based on a maximum of 35 points.

Appendix 1 provides the full details of each open space quality assessment. Figure 52 illustrates an example of a score sheet. The quality assessments have been grouped under each settlement, and within each settlement headed under each typology.

It scored particularly low in the facilities category; improvements to this category could enhance this space. The main entrance to this site is over a bridge that crosses over the River Exe however there are some concerns for safety especially for smaller children as there is no solid fencing on either side of the bridge. The bridge also needs some small repairs and maintenance work to the timber. It is also very narrow which means there is no access for wheelchairs. Although minimising accessibility, the bridge along with a thatched pavilion adds to the character of the space, a feature which cannot be measured within this scoring system. All of this open space apart from the pavilion is in an area of high flood risk.</p>
