

### **KEY FEATURES**

- Grazing license available by informal tender.
- The land is a mixture of moorland (175 ha/432 ac) and grassland (135 ha/333.5 ac).
- Native Breed at Risk cattle required.
- April 15th 2025 31st December 2025.
- Stock fencing around perimeter.
- Spring water available at no cost.
- No infrastructure available.
- Conservation grazing approach.



Driver Farm Simonsbath Somerset TA24 7LH Exmoor National Park Authority is offering the opportunity to graze its land at Driver Farm, an upland holding, covering approximately 310 ha (766 ac).

### **CONDITIONS**

- The grazier shall keep an appropriate number of the graziers own cattle on the land having regard to the type, quality, productivity and drainage of the soil as well as the pasture so as to prevent any poaching, erosion or damage to the sward.
- The cattle must be registered pedigree animals, of a Defra Native Breed At Risk (NBAR) listed breed.
- The grazier is to comply with any limitations on stocking density, grazing, mowing, or related management imposed.
- The grazier is to be solely responsible as keeper of the animals for all compliance with the law on animal identification animal passports and movement recording and reporting for the animals and animal welfare and adhere to the requirements of Statutory Management Requirement 7 (Cattle identification and registration).
- The grazier is to manage the cattle in accordance with the 'Farming Rules' meaning the (i) Animal Legislation, (ii) the "Rules for farmers and land managers" guidance set by Defra, and any (iii) rules, guidance or requirements set by Defra.
- The grazier is to obtain a Temporary Land Association or temporary CPH (Holding) Number for the Land from the Animal & Plant Health Agency (APHA).
- The grazier is to take out and maintain appropriate public liability insurance for their business and any damage arising from the animals.
- The grazier is not to obstruct any public or private right of way on the land or any access by any other party to any other land belonging to the Authority.
- The grazier is not permitted to spread compound fertiliser (lime, pesticides, herbicides, or other chemical treatment) or manure.
- The Authority retains control, possession and management of the land and the grazier will have no right to exclude the Authority (or any agent or employee of the Authority) or others authorised by the Authority from the land.
- The grazier shall occupy the land as a licensee. No relationship of landlord and tenant will be created between the Authority and the grazier.
- The Authority's own Exmoor Ponies will also graze the land.
- The grazier shall keep a monthly record of stock numbers grazing on Parcels and submit to the Authority.

### **GRASSLAND GRAZING REQUIREMENTS**

**Grassland 1** is home to the Driver and Pinkworthy SSSI. The grazing objective is to work towards a sward that is 3cm – 6cm in height.

**Grassland 2** this area will be closed off from grazing until an August hay cut and then requires aftermath grazing. The aim here is to graze the sward to a height between 3cm - 5cm.

The below stocking density table therefore relates to both grassland 1 and 2 units - identified in blue and yellow on the relevant plan. To calculate your livestock numbers depending on your chosen breed and age class, please refer to page 4, Livestock Information.

### MOORLAND GRAZING REQUIRMENTS

The moorland units are home to the North Exmoor SSSI. The key objective on the moorland units is to graze off the Molinia throughout the season.

The below stocking density table therefore relates to the moorland units – identified in pink on the relevant plan. To calculate your livestock numbers depending on your breed and age class, please refer to page 4, Livestock Information.
